Q1. Define transport. How has it changed over time?

Ans. Transport refers to a system of carrying people and goods from one place to another by land, air or water.

- In ancient times, animals such as horses were used for travelling and transporting goods. In the 1700s, steam engine were developed.
- In the 1800s and 1900s, people began using fuel-powered automobiles for transport.
- In 1903, Orville and Wilbur Wright, together known as the Wright brothers, built the first aeroplane.

Q2. How are roadways useful? Name a highway network that links India's four big cities.

Ans. Roadways are a very convenient means for transporting people and goods on land. Roads can be built both in the plains and the mountains.

• The Golden Quadrilateral is a highway network that links India's four major cities namely Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata.

Q3. Write a brief note on waterways. Name any three major ports of India.

Ans.

The means of transport over water include boats, steamers and ships of all sizes.
 Water transport is a slower, but a cheaper way to carry heavy goods over long distances.

• Waterways are mainly of two types—inland waterways and sea and oceanic routes. Cochin Port, Chennai Port and Kolkata Port are three major ports in India.
