## HAUSLA - ANNUAL NCC FEST

### 1. Combat – A Test of Strength, Agility, and Tactical Skill

One of the most prestigious and action-packed events of *Hausla*, Combat is a true test of a cadet’s physical endurance, mental alertness, and battlefield strategy.

A standout feature of Combat is the powerful demonstration of **unarmed combat techniques**, where cadets showcase self-defense skills, precision strikes, and controlled takedowns — reflecting their training in discipline, reflex, and combat readiness.

### 2. NIAP (National Integration Awareness Programme) – Featuring group performance and themed displays.

As a vital part of *Hausla*, NIAP (National Integration Awareness Programme) stands as a powerful platform for cadets to promote **unity in diversity** through **group performances, cultural displays, and thematic presentations**. 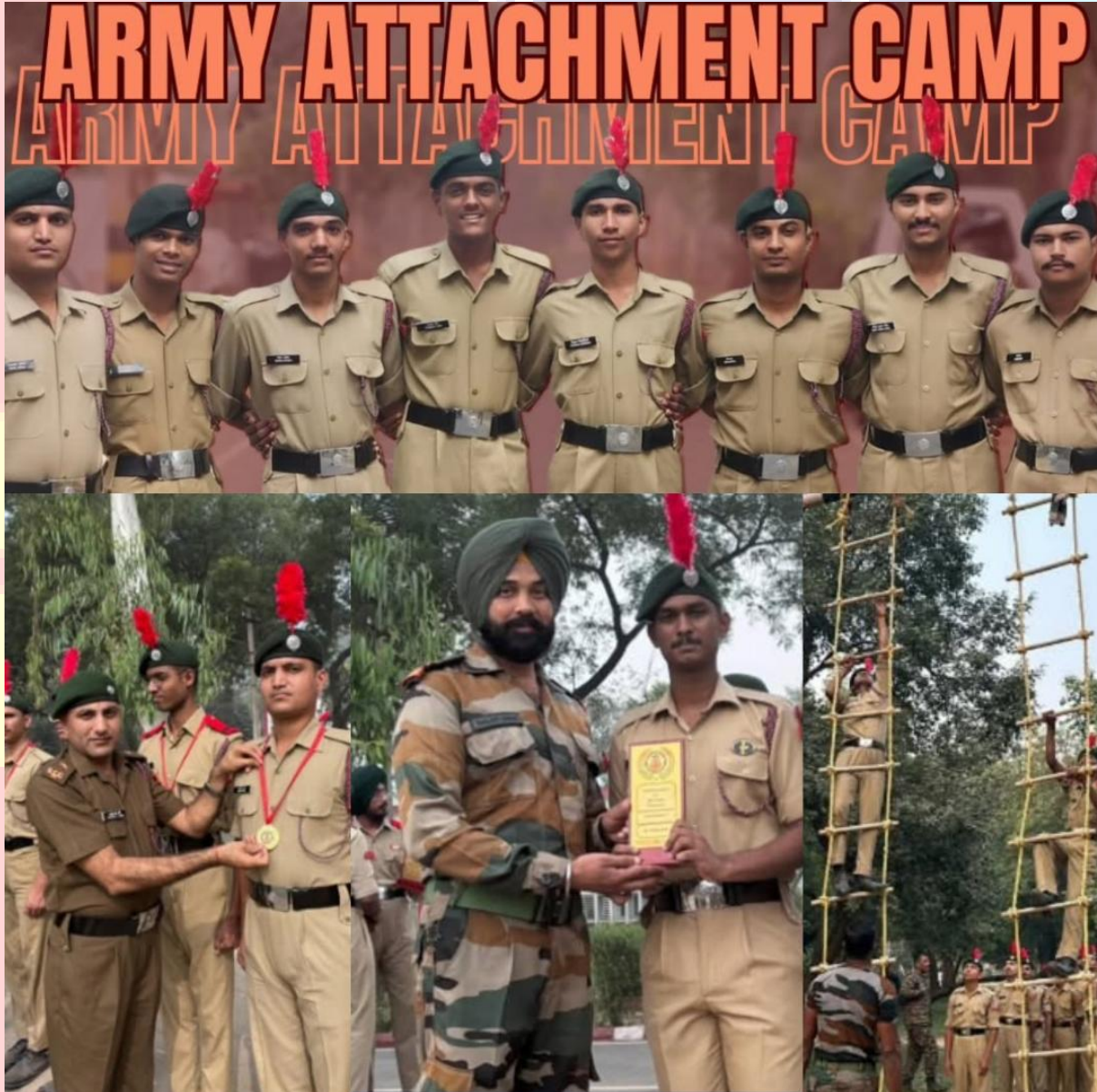

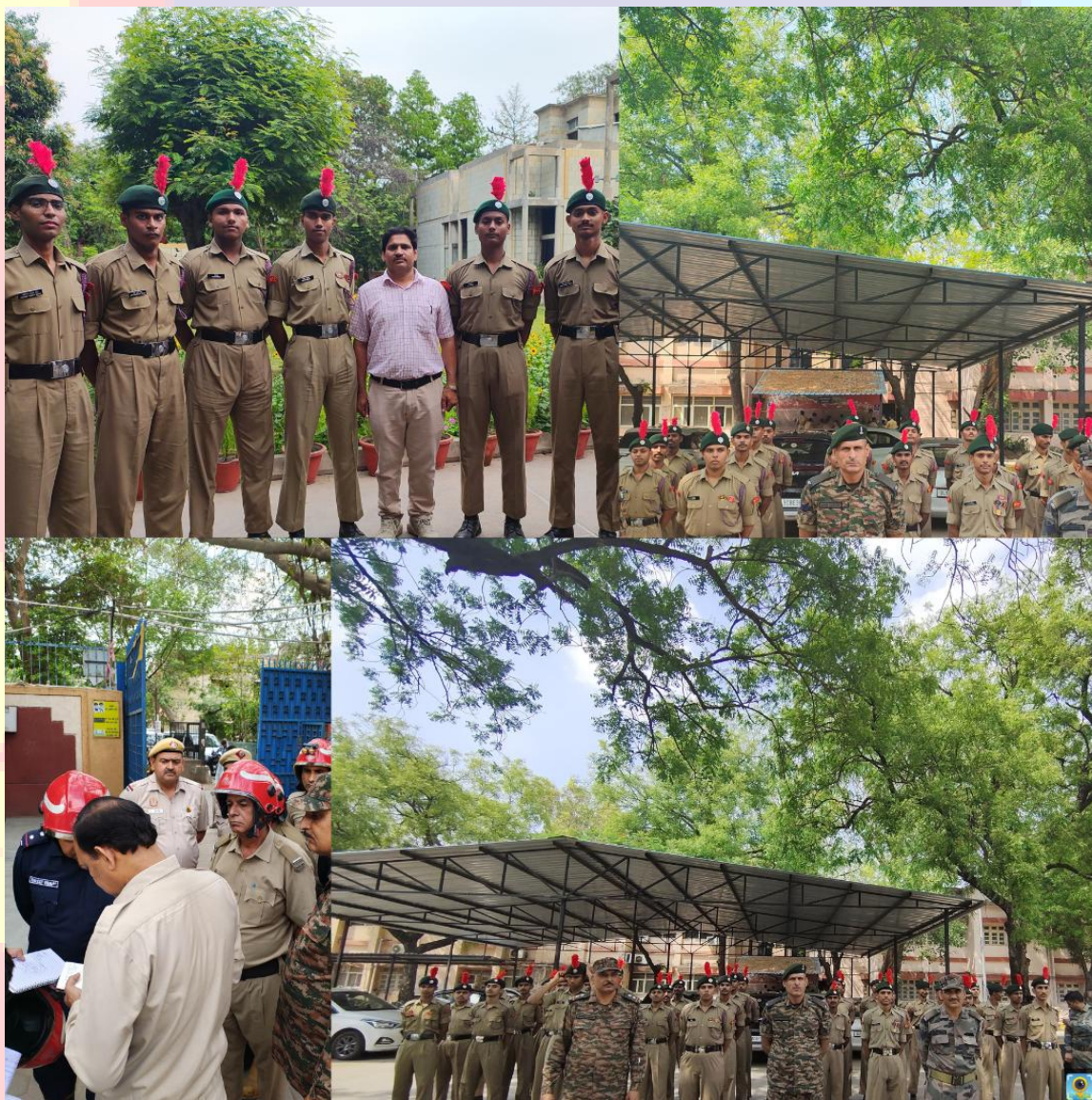
## **2.Our Cadets Participated in Global Roti Day Organised By Vishalakshi Foundation in collaboration with our company.**
